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## Section 3: Program Expectations

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### Technology & Internet Access

- A computer, tablet, or smartphone with a camera and microphone is needed.
- Families are responsible for internet access. Affordable options can be shared upon request.
- Students are encouraged to use STREAM 180 virtual backgrounds to protect home privacy.

### Safety & Privacy

To protect every participant:

- All sessions require a waiting room and passcode.
- Only staff, volunteers, and approved guests may share screens.
- No recordings, screenshots, or photos of sessions.
- Do not share Zoom links with others.
- Students use only their first name and last initial (e.g., Jamal R.).
- Staff may enter any breakout room at any time.
- Mentors and staff are mandated reporters who must report safety concerns or suspected abuse.

### Student Conduct

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# Student Code of Conduct & Pledge

STREAM 180 is more than an afterschool program. It's a safe space where everyone belongs. We meet online to learn, share ideas, and support each other. Every student, mentor, and staff member plays a part in creating a community built on respect, trust, and kindness. When you join STREAM 180, you agree to help keep our virtual environment positive, focused, and safe for everyone.

## The “Be” Rules

### 1. Be Present

- Be on time, prepared, and ready to learn.
- Use your real first name or approved nickname when logging in.
- Keep your camera on during sessions unless told otherwise.
- Stay fully dressed in school-appropriate clothing while on camera.
- Use a blurred or STREAM 180 virtual background to protect your privacy.
- Limit distractions (phones, games, or other tabs).
- If you can't attend a project that you are a part of, let us know ahead of time.

*We understand that life happens— just do your best and communicate with us.*

### 2. Be Respectful

- Treat everyone with respect — no teasing, bullying, or name-calling.
- Listen when others speak — one mic, one voice.
- Use positive and encouraging language.
- Be patient with yourself and others.
- Use respectful language at all times — no profanity, slurs, or offensive comments, spoken or typed.

*Kindness keeps our space safe and welcoming.*

### 3. Be Safe

- Protect your privacy and the privacy of others.
- Never share program Zoom links or passwords.
- No recording, screenshots, or photos during sessions.
- Do not post or share STREAM 180 content (videos, photos, screenshots, or chats) on social media, text messages, or group chats.
- Never share personal information like your address, school name, or phone number.
- Use program chat features only for learning-related communication.

*What happens in our sessions stays private. We protect each other.*

#### 4. Be Alert

- Ask questions when something isn't clear.
- Tell a mentor or staff member right away if you feel unsafe or uncomfortable.
- Let us know if you see or hear something that isn't right.
- Remember: speaking up for safety is how we take care of our community.

*Your voice matters. If something feels off, say so.*

#### 5. Be Accountable

- Be honest about mistakes and open to feedback.
- If you slip up, own it and work to make it right.
- Use technology responsibly — no trolling, cheating, or copying others' work.
- Respect program spaces the same way you would a classroom or community center.

Accountability is not punishment. Everyone messes up sometimes. What matters is how we fix it.

#### 6. Be a Good Citizen

Being online is part of how we learn and connect. STREAM 180 students agree to:

- Use technology in honest, respectful, and safe ways.
- Ask mentors before using AI tools or online programs during tutoring or projects.
- Keep digital communication (texts, chat, emoji, or posts) appropriate and respectful.
- Treat your digital actions — typing, texting, sharing — as real interactions that affect others.

*Your online choices shape how people see you. Lead with respect — it lasts longer than a post.*

#### 7. Be Informed

Everyone makes mistakes. What matters most is how we handle them.

If a rule is broken:

- A mentor or staff member will talk with you privately to understand what happened.
- Together, you'll find a fair solution and plan to move forward.
- If the issue continues, your parent or guardian may be contacted.
- Serious or repeated issues may result in a short break or removal from the program.

*We'll always start with conversation, fairness, and understanding.*

# Media, Photography, and Creative Works Release Form

STREAM 180 is a program of Change Your Story, Inc. STREAM 180 uses photos, videos, and student work to highlight learning, support staff training, and document program impact. This form explains how STREAM 180 may capture and use media and creative content involving your child. Participation in the program requires permission for internal use, as this is part of our standard learning and reporting process.

### I. Required Internal Program Use

The STREAM 180 program may take photos, screenshots, or short video clips of students during live or recorded sessions for internal program purposes, which include:

- Displaying student work and participation in class.
- Creating internal training materials for our staff, volunteers, mentors, and partners.
- Program evaluation, documentation, and funder reporting.

These materials are viewed only by authorized STREAM 180 staff and approved program partners under confidentiality agreements.

#### **Consent for internal use is required for program participation.**

By enrolling in STREAM 180, you grant permission for these internal uses as part of normal program operations.

### 2. Optional External and Public Use

STREAM 180 may occasionally use student photos, short videos, or creative work for public-facing communications, including:

- Newsletters, brochures, and community updates
- STREAM 180's website or official social media pages
- Presentations, events, or grant reports

When used publicly:

- Student's first name or approved nickname may be visible (such as when participant groups are in the approved Zoom room)
- No personal details (such as students last name, address, school, or contact info) will be shared.
- All content will be used respectfully and solely to promote STREAM 180's mission.

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# Technology & Internet Safety Agreement

STREAM 180 is a program of Change Your Story, Inc., that takes place online using Zoom. To keep everyone safe and connected, all parent/guardians, and students agree to follow these technology and internet safety rules. These expectations help protect each student's privacy and ensures every session runs smoothly as possible.

### 1. Technology Access

- Use a computer, tablet, or smartphone with a working camera and microphone.
- Keep your device charged and ready before each session.
- Make sure you have a stable internet connection.
- If your connection or device isn't working, let a mentor or staff member know — we'll help you find a solution.
- If you regularly can't connect with video or audio, we'll reach out to figure out what's going on.

### 2. Secure Program Access

- Every STREAM 180 session uses a Zoom link and passcode.
- Join only through links shared by the program — never forward them to anyone else.
- Always wait in the virtual waiting room until staff let you in.
- If you see someone that you believe should not be in our Zoom room, alert staff right away.

### 3. Camera and Background Rules

- Keep your camera on during sessions unless told otherwise.
- Stay fully dressed in school-appropriate clothing while on camera.
- Use a blurred or STREAM 180 background to keep your space private.
- Stay visible — not lying down, off-screen, or walking around during class.
- If your camera or background isn't working, tell a staff member so we can help.

### 4. Photos, Screenshots, and Social Media

- Do not record, screenshot, or take photos of STREAM 180 sessions at any time.
- Do not post or share videos, pictures, or chat messages from sessions on social media, group chats, or with anyone outside the program.
- Keep what happens in STREAM 180 sessions private.
- Sharing or posting content without permission is a serious safety violation and can lead to removal from the program.

### 5. Device Safety and Online Behavior

- Use your device for program activities only while in session.
- Keep food, drinks, and distractions away from your device when possible.
- Do not use side chats, DMs, or social media to message others about STREAM 180.
- Be respectful in all communication — no profanity, slurs, or inappropriate emojis or memes.
- Ask before using AI tools or online helpers during tutoring or projects.
- Remember, your online actions represent you.

## 6. Privacy and Personal Information

- Protect your personal information at all times.
- Never share your home address, school name, or phone number in chat.
- STREAM 180 staff will never ask you for personal passwords or private social media handles.
- Mentors and staff follow strict safety and privacy rules, but your best protection is your own awareness.
- If something feels off, tell a mentor or trusted adult right away.

## 7. If Problems Come Up

Everyone makes mistakes — what matters is how we fix them.

If technology rules are broken:

- You'll get a private reminder from a mentor or staff member.
- If the issue continues, your parent or guardian will be contacted.
- Serious or repeated issues — like recording, sharing content, or unsafe online behavior — can lead to removal from the program.
- We always start with conversation and fairness, not punishment.
